Some Guidelines for the Thesis Committee

1. Almost without exception, students who are awarded Honors or Highest Honors in Political Science receive the grade of " $A$ " for the thesis. If a student does not successfully defend a thesis for Honors, the highest grade the student can receive for the thesis is B+. The thesis grade constitutes $2 / 3$ of the final grade for POLI 692 H and should be the basis for the course grade for POLI 693H. It should be stressed that even if a student is not awarded Honors, a grade will be assigned for POLI 692H and POLI 693H (commensurate with the quality of the work) and the student will receive course credit.
2. A degree with Highest Honors is not awarded often. It is reserved for those students who write truly exceptional theses.
3. The award of Honors or Highest Honors is based upon the quality of the honors thesis. While a minimum GPA of 3.8 in Political Science is necessary to graduate with Highest Honors, this grade point average in no way entitles a student to an award of Highest Honors.
